


Day 1 (Activity 3)

How to Login on Oculus?

1. Go to url: **auth.oculus.com**

On landing page you have option to Log In using your Facebook/Instagram account



2. In case you don't have an account, you can setup one by creating a Facebook account.


Once account is created you can to link in Point 1. And Log in now.




3. Using same credentials you used to Sign up can be used to Log In to your Oculus Headset

Setting up Play Ares for Oculus?

1. Most of activities pertaining to AR/VR will be done by respective candidates being in their seated position assigned to them, so always choose **Stationary Boundary** instead of **Room Scale Boundary**.



Room Scale Boundary is preferred when there is scope to move around in your/environment.




This **Stationary Boundary** will help you stay within your cleared play area. It will appear in your VR experience when you're near or touching its edge.

At any point you can change play area preferences from Oculus **Settings** from Guardian option


Setting up Oculus Casting?

Note: PC/Laptop and Oculus should be connected over same Wi-Fi Network


1. On you PC/Laptop go to tinyurl.com/w-help and scroll down to **Important Links** and click on **Cast Oculus** or go to **Oculus.com/casting**




2. You will land on **Oculus Casting Login** Page. Login using the same credentials you used on Oculus headset.




3. Now you can see the PC/Laptop is ready to cast your Oculus.



4. Now turn-on Oculus and you will land on **Universal Menu** where you can find **Share** button.



5. Now click on **Cast** button



6. Now you can see you PC/Laptop in list of connected devices ready to cast your Oculus. Select your device and start casting.
